The Label is the Law!

OK, we say it all the time, "Read and follow all the label instructions." Why? Because the label is a legal document stating important product information!

The label answers all your questions, such as:

- ✓ The active ingredient & mode of action group number.
- ✓ Is it a Restricted Use Product?
- ✓ If it is an insecticide, is it Bee-Friendly?
- ✓ Check the weed species list for what weeds can be controlled and the crop/weed stage when it is the most effective?
- ✓ What rate of the product to use? How much is allowed to be applied in a year?
- ✓ How should it be mixed? What other products, fertilizers or additives can be used with it?
- ✓ What application equipment is the best to use? Can it be tankmixed?
- ✓ What temperatures are best when spraying?
- ✓ How much wind before you should stop spraying? Read the information on drift management.
- ✓ What personal protection equipment (PPE) is required for product use?
- ✓ Who to call in case of an emergency?
- ✓ Where and how should any leftover product be stored?
- ✓ What are the environmental hazards, such as, can it be sprayed near water, soil movement, and residual effects?
- ✓ Seriously need to check the crop specific use rates, and the rotational restrictions before spraying!

All this and so much more is available on the product label.

So, once again: Read the Label. It is the Law!
