FALL NOXIOUS SPECIES APPLICATION

As summer spraying comes to an end, it is not always a consideration that the key to successful noxious weed control comes from fall applications as well.

Particularly in the case of **Dalmatian Toadflax** and **Cheatgrass (Downy Brome)**. Spraying Toadflax in the fall as it dies back allows for the chemical to be drawn down into the plant's root system. Cheatgrass (Downy Brome) is a winter annual. Spraying between the middle of August and the middle of October in the late pre-emergence to the early post-emergence stage allows for a more effective application.

Rejuvra is an extremely effective herbicide. While it is more expensive, it lasts far longer than alternatives. *Plateau* is also a great option that is more cost effective, however it will have to be applied more frequently for desired results.

Both are root inhibiting herbicides that remain on top of the soil in order to prevent the germination of weeds, but leave desirable perennial grasses and forbs undisturbed.
