EARLY DETECTION RAPID RESPONSE (EDRR)

As Spring comes around the corner in these upcoming months, it is dire that landowners & managers alike keep their eyes out for invading pests. Early Detection Rapid Response is a monitoring practice to identify weed & pest infestations before they mature into a larger problem that is more difficult to manage.

Being able to identify invasion early makes you more likely to be able to effectively control pest populations and keep control costs lower. A good practice to employ is to make yourself aware of common pests in your area, or find resources that can assist you in doing so. Learning growth habits, lifecycles, and what pests look like through different stages of development can also be valuable supplementary information

Your local Laramie County Weed & Pest office is available to walk through your property or identify samples that are brought into our offices. We appreciate our residents willingness to protect and defend our native landscape!



As a Weed & Pest District, it is our duty to control designated & declared weed and pest species in our county. Species found on either of these lists are our highest control priority and have been proven to be detrimental, destructive, injurious or poisonous, either by virtue of their direct effect or as carriers of diseases or parasites. These Wyoming State Designated & Declared Pest lists can be found on our website laramiecountyweedandpest.com.

While there are other species of plants, insects, or animals that classify in one way or another as pests, we are only allowed to control or facilitate programs tailored after the species on these lists. While we cannot directly assist in matters involving pests outside of these legal designations/declarations, we are still happy to assist landowners by finding information or resources that can assist them in management practices beyond our scope.
