## Do Not Spray Program

The Laramie County Weed & Pest through an agreement with Laramie County is tasked with weed control in the County Road rights-of-way (ROW).

Each summer we spray the ROW to control the noxious weeds on the State and County weed lists. See the noxious weed pictures on our website: [www.laramiecountyweedandpest.com](http://www.laramiecountyweedandpest.com).

Effective March 3, 2022, the Board of Directors has approved a program for any landowner who does not want us to spray the ROW next to their property.

✂ To be eligible, landowners must:

(1) Contact the Pine Bluffs office only to complete an agreement and get approval.

(2) Purchase the approved “do not spray” signs to mark the beginning and end of their property.

Available at the Pine Bluffs or Archer offices.

(3) Landowners MUST control the weeds at all times during the growing season to prevent them from producing seed. Control can be by pulling, chopping, digging, or mowing. Hand spraying is also acceptable. If Field Bindweed is present, chemical spraying may be the only effective control method.

(4) If these conditions are not met, Weed & Pest will spray the ROW.

Effective weed management starts with a healthy pasture. Weeds are seldom a serious problem in a well-managed, vigorously growing pasture. Managing weeds is both an economical & environmentally sound approach to weed control.

Your plan should include scouting (checking for weeds frequently), prevention (use weed-free forage), control (chemical, mechanical, and biological) all in a well-coordinated plan. Taking control of the weeds will make your pasture the envy of the neighborhood.
